Issues Fixed by this Upgrade

The current Luminis Platform upgrade resolves a number of issues reported against previous Luminis Platform versions and consolidates all hotfixes previously released for Luminis Platform. The following table contains a list of the primary defects fixed in this release.

1-5438EI	Return Receipt is now honored after an e-mail send error has occurred.
1-5438EO	Original attachments to e-mails are preserved when a new attachment operation is cancelled.
1-5438GG	The original text editing mode is retained when editing an existing draft message.
1-57PXHN	Admin must delete bad entries from UP_GROUP_MEMBERSHIP table for channel sub-categories to migrate correctly.
1-5H3YIY	If IdM is enabled on LDI XML import, user fields are set the same regardless of the udc.idm.enabled flag setting.
1-5GCMR9	Browser check function updated to support latest versions of IE, Firefox and Safari.
1-55HU6I	In-line frame channels now display properly in IE8.
1-5EOMV2	The .cprc header comment is corrected.
1-5KSCGF	A workaround is provided for highly confidential groups.

Request for Highly Confidential Group

When the system administrator receives a request for a highly confidential group, the Group Confidentiality section of the request is shown as Non Anonymous. Administrators must be careful to select the Highly Confidential radio button. Before approving or rejecting the request.
