LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT: No German proficiency required, however, a minimum of 1 year of German instruction is highly recommended. If planning to attend classes taught in German, B2 proficiency in German is required.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 15 (Academic Year); May 1 (Spring Semester)

WHY UNI GRAZ: The University has 6 faculties, 76 departments and offers 100 different fields of study. 31.500 students are studying at Graz University, 13% of those are international students. Graz University is a comprehensive university with a strong international profile, it is Austria's 2nd oldest university and one of the largest in the country. One main focus is offering innovative interdisciplinary research & research-based teaching.

Graz is a charming student town in the heart of Europe. It is the second largest city in Austria with about 300.000 inhabitants (of which 60.000 are students) and it is the capital of Styria. Graz has been awarded the title of UNESCO's World Heritage. In 2003, Graz was the Cultural Capital of Europe.
